

Niko's Dance Team Code of Conduct

I understand and agree to the following:

- This is a 9-month program with **possibilities** of extra or canceled rehearsals. Season runs September 9, 2024-May 23, 2025
- Students must have proper dance attire for each class. Hair must be tied back securely, and no jewelry is allowed.
- Students will be asked to leave the class if not dressed in proper dance attire.
- All students must treat the studio, premises, and the possessions of all other dancers with respect, care, and consideration.
- All students are expected to clean up after themselves and any mess that they create while at the studio.
- All students are expected to demonstrate respect for all instructors, assistants, staff members, and fellow students.
- Poor Sportsmanship can result in dismissal from studio at the teacher's discretion.
- Instructors reserve the right to dismiss student if rules are not followed and respected.
- At the age of 9, students must be enrolled in a Ballet tech class, if enrolled in any of the following classes: Jazz, Tap, Lyrical, Contemporary, Ukrainian
- The studio **MUST** be informed of any illness or conditions that arise during the year that may affect the attendance or ability of dancer or others.
- After December 31st, if a student misses' classes, does not follow rules, or lacks effort and enthusiasm during class, it is at the instructor's discretion to remove the student from competing & performing choreography.
- After December 31st, if your account is in arrears, it is at the studio's discretion to remove student from competing & performing choreography.
- The studio reserves the right to cancel classes due to inclement weather, hazardous road conditions or other emergencies.
- Tuition fees are due regardless of illness, weather, disciplinary reasons, vacations etc.
- The studio must be notified of any changes or withdrawals from classes. Written notice must be provided within 30 days.
- All concerns must be brought to Niko's administration only. If the instructor(s) need to be made aware of the concerns or a meeting between parent and instructor is required, Niko's administration will make the appropriate arrangements.
